Battling the unpredictable tides and the expanse of the open seas. I embarked on an extraordinary adventure that tested not only my physical but also my mental fortitude.

Setting off from the starting point on Tabarca Island, I dove into the azure depths with unwavering resolve. Each stroke propelled myself and the 15 others forward, inching closer to their destination. The hours stretched ahead of me, but my determination remained unwavering. Fatigue threatened to take its toll, but we persisted, drawing strength from months of training and the love for the sea.

Throughout the arduous swim, I encountered both moments of tranquillity and challenges that tested their resolve. Encouraged by the cheers of support crew and the knowledge that my goal was within reach, I rounded the final buoy marking the 100m mark from the Finish Line and pushed through the last moments of the gruelling swim

Finally, after just a little over 8 hours of unwavering dedication, I finally emerged triumphant onto the sandy shores of Urbanova Beach. Exhausted yet elated, I had conquered the distance that once seemed insurmountable. The few familiar faces and a couple strangers erupted in applause, only then fully recognizing the incredible feat I had accomplished.

Completing a gruelling 21-kilometer open water swim, equivalent to a double marathon, is an extraordinary feat that evokes a whirlwind of physical sensations. 

Gavels Club added another trophy to the shelf. With mentor advice and team support, we were able to place among the top three in the evaluation compettion.





its golden sun with eight rays, symbolizing the initial eight Philippine provinces that resisted Spanish colonial rule. Following the flag-raising, the San Francisco de Malabon marching band played the country's national anthem, "Lupang Hinirang," for the first time.

Previously, Filipinos celebrated Independence Day on July 4, coinciding with the U.S. Independence Day. However, in 1962, President Diosdado Macapagal changed the date to June 12 to commemorate the end of Spanish rule in the Philippines.

I extend my gratitude to Westford University College for providing me with the opportunity to share information about the national day of my homeland. As a Filipino, I take immense pride in my heritage.
