Thrift for Good is a charity thrift shop with a mission to rehome preloved items, reduce waste, and support children worldwide by donating 100% of profits to the local non-profit Gulf for Good. The thrift store offers a range of stylish and branded clothing, accessories, bags, shoes, and books at affordable prices, encouraging a zero-waste solution by accepting unwanted clothing donations.

During the initial class visit, students received an orientation, a tour, and a project briefing from key personnel at Thrift for Good.
